"...If you abide in My word, then you are truly disciples of Mine; and you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." - John 8:31b - 32

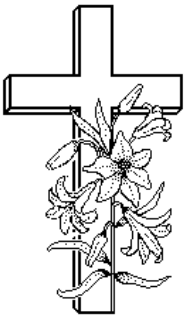

When a believer is redeemed (saved) by obedience to the gospel (Death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus Christ – **Acts. 2:38; 1 Cor. 15:1 - 4**), he/she enters into the Christian life. (**Matt. 28:19; Acts 2:38**) Only then is the believer given divine enablement that is God's help for daily life experiences. All believers need the help of God because of the constant lure of Satan to sin. (**Rom. 6:23**) We also face trials and tribulations, some because of the choices we make, and others are due to the forces of darkness that are around us. Essentially, every day presents some sort of conflict that we must evaluate and handle by yielding to the Holy Spirit who works through the word of God.

As early as we can remember, some sort of painful experience brought hurt or disappointment into our emotional circumstances. Often, many of us go through situations where we are hurt on a regular bases and seldom do we experience healing for our condition. When this is the case, our emotional hurt can leave us feeling vulnerable, feeling alone and empty. In this state we are in constant need. Unresolved emotional neediness can drive us to participate in further destructive/sinful behavior that only deepens our despair and inability to cope.

There are many Christians all over the world who would like to serve God by using their gifts and abilities. Yet, only because they are unaware of God's healing strategy, they remain stuck and unable to achieve spiritual potential. Many no doubt are afraid to get involved in meaningful Kingdom activity because their hurt disturbs their wellbeing. If they only knew how God heals their grief and sense of guilt and shame.

The problem many believers are having with being stuck and unavailable for spiritual growth and development is rooted in their method of coping with their history of unresolved pain. Some stuck believers try to work out their emotional pain by applying secular methods, only to become worn-out and broken over time. When they discover that vocational achievement, money, and pleasure do not heal the pain, they can become hopeless. Others who surrender to their pain are then overtaken by emotional frustration and enter into a worse condition, usually addictive behaviors. What all disciples need to know for sure is that the truth not only frees us, it also heals all our present and future emotional pains. Liberating us from the grip sin and freeing us to access God's resilient enabling power to regain our standing with Him **Psalms 30-40**.
