In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make your paths straight." Prov. 3:5,6*

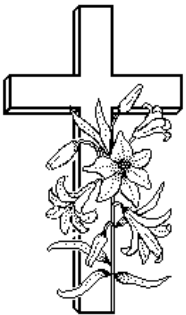

In part one of this message we explored how God was able to use people like Adam and Eve, Noah, and Abraham in spite of their human struggle to succeed in important work that could advance God's will in the world. My hope is that all Christians will learn from those who struggled in the past to see through their weaknesses and blind spots by repenting and moving forward (Luke. 13:3,5; Acts 17:30). Otherwise, we will surrender to our faults (guilt & shame) and become victims to our distress. If that happens we will be of no use to ourselves, other people, or God. If we desire to have a stronger posture in life and avoid falling short of the glory of God (sin) it would do us well to grasp the teaching of proverbs 3:5, 6 and apply it to daily living.

To trust in the Lord, we must learn to feel safe and secure with His will for our lives. This will be evidenced while we remain true to God's word that brings spiritual development and conviction to please Him above the philosophy of this world. So often the mistake that we make as we deal with trials and tribulations, which easily leads us into sin, is to become impulsive (an emotional reaction rooted in the flesh) instead of seeking understanding to respond to the truth (John 17:17). If we were more disciplined to consult His word for wisdom and prudence (discernment) to learn how to avoid bringing distress and frustration into our situation the end results would glorify God and not shame us. What we do not seem to realize is that every decision we make good or bad has an impact on our spirit/conscious. When we make sinful mistakes because of a lack of awareness our spirit will be grieved and discouraged. What good does that condition serve us while we deal with a host of challenges that are basic to everyday living. Will we be positive and optimistic or will doubt dominate our mind and emotions and cloud our decision-making skills.

Thus, in all our ways, as we walk through this life revealing our actions and behaviors, we must of profound necessity acknowledge God for wholeness and holiness sake. If we would just ask ourselves through our senses, how will God be glorified in this situation or circumstance or with this person and apply with conviction god like action, we would experience His objectives. This is how God makes our path straight. To be lawful, upright and tranquil is to be liberated and capable of expressing our wholeness and holiness that comes from God.
